


Take this undemanding return walk in Morton National Park eucalypt forest for the scenic views of the waterfalls and a picnic by the lookout. Let us begin by acknowledging the Wodi Wodi & Wandandian people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.



Class 3 of 6 Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles	
Quality of track	Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles (3/6)
Gradient	Gentle hills with occasional steps (2/6)
Signage	Directional signs along the way (3/6)
Infrastructure	Limited facilities, not all cliffs are fenced (3/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (2/6)
Weather	Storms may impact on navigation and safety (3/6)

Getting to the start: From Princes Highway, A1

- Turn on to Twelve Mile Road then drive for 6.4 km
- Turn right onto Tin Mine Road and drive for another 810 m




Before you start any journey ensure you;


- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.

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Start.




After 50 m pass the "Granite Falls Carpark" (20 m on your left).



After another 245 m pass a seat (15 m on your left)., has no backrest.



After another 170 m head down the steps



(Granite Falls Lookout) Continue another 55 m to find the end. Then turn around here and retrace the main route for 520 m to get back to the start.
