


## Iluka Rainforest Walking Track (Gumbaingirr & Yaegl Country)











Starting from Long Street this one-way walk will guide you through Iluka Nature Reserve. There's a 'Sensing the rainforest' area for children up to 6 years old along the way. Walk all the way to the Iluka Bluff Lookout for great views over the ocean and finish it off with a lunch at the Iluka Bluff picnic area. Let us begin by acknowledging the Gumbaingirr & Yaegl people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.










- Turn on to Spenser Street then drive for 460 m
- Turn left onto Vere Street and drive for another 350 m


## Before you start any journey ensure you;


- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- · Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey


If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.












Find the sign at the start.



After another 1.4 km veer right.



After another 1.1 km turn right.



After another 40 m turn sharp right.



After another 10 m turn left.



After another 60 m head up the surface|wood steps (about 20 m long)



Then pass the shelter (on your right).



Then pass the sign (6 m on your right).



Then pass the toilet (20 m on your right).



After another 165 m come to "Iluka Bluff Lookout".
