

Devils Hole Lookout Walk and Picnic Area (Biripi & Worimi Country)










From Devils Hole campground and picnic area, this short return accessible walk in Barrington Tops National Park takes you to the Devils Hole lookout with a great view over Barrington plateau. Let us begin by acknowledging the Biripi & Worimi people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.





Class 1 of 6 Smooth and hardened path	
Quality of track	Smooth and hardened path (1/6)
Gradient	Flat, no steps (1/6)
Signage	Clearly signposted (1/6)
Infrastructure	Generally useful facilities (such as fenced cliffs and seats) (1/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (1/6)
Weather	Weather generally has little impact on safety (1/6)



Getting to the start: From Thunderbolts Way, Barrington.


• Turn on to Scone Road, 29 then drive for 53.4 km


Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- $\bullet \ \ \text{Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills \& knowledge to undertake this journey safely}\\$
- · Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.









- Find the car park at the start.
- Find the Devils Hole Camping Area at the start.
- Find the toilet at the start.
- After another 6 m pass the sign (on your right).
- After another 135 m come to "Devils Hole Lookout".

Turn around here and retrace the main route for 175 m to get back to the start.
