If you're up for it take a stroll north along the beach to Abbey Creek picnic area and have a picnic before heading back. Let us begin by acknowledging the Biripi \& Worimi people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

After 50 m pass the BBQ ( 45 m on your left).
Then pass the shelter ( 45 m on your left).

Continue another 295 m to find the end. Then turn around here and retrace the main route for 345 m to get back to the start.
