

## North Head Walking Track (Bundjalung Country)



20 min to 40 min









Starting from the end of North Head Road take this short return walk through coastal rainforest to Brunswick River for lovely views and a picnic. Let us begin by acknowledging the Bundjalung people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.







Class 2 of 6 Clear and well formed track or trail	
Quality of track	Clear and well formed track or trail (2/6)
Gradient	Gentle hills with occasional steps (2/6)
Signage	Clearly signposted (2/6)
Infrastructure	Generally useful facilities (such as fenced cliffs and seats) (2/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (2/6)
Weather	Weather generally has little impact on safety (2/6)

Getting to the start: From Brunswick Valley Way, 40

- Turn on to Rajah Road then drive for 1.6 km
- Turn slight left onto Yengarie Way and drive for another 185 m
- Turn sharp right onto Orana Road and drive for another 800 m
- Turn right onto North Head Road and drive for another 2.1 km
- Continue onto North Head Road and drive for another 85 m


## Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.










After 120 m to find the toilet.



Continue another 390 m to find the end. Then turn around here and retrace the main route for 690 m to get back to the start.
