


Sublime Point Walking Track (Dharawal Country)










Starting from Sublime Point this return walk takes you along a challenging walk descending toward Austinmer. If the ascend back is too much, you can make it a one-way track and catch a ride from Austinmer back to start or return via the same way. Let us begin by acknowledging the Dharawal people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.






Class 4 of 6 Rough track, where fallen trees and other obstacles are likely	
Quality of track	Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles (3/6)
Gradient	Very steep (4/6)
Signage	Clearly signposted (2/6)
Infrastructure	Limited facilities (such as cliffs not fenced, significant creeks not bridged) (4/6)
Experience Required	Some bushwalking experience recommended (3/6)
Weather	Foretasted & unexpected storms and severe weather may impact on navigation and safety (4/6)


Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.









Start.



After another 25 m (Sublime Point Lookout) **turn right**.



Then pass the shelter (120 m on your left).



Then pass the toilet (55 m on your left).



After another 40 m pass the water tap (on your left)



After another 25 m come to the "Sublime Point Lookout".



Then pass the "Sublime Point Cafe" (20 m on your right).



After another 50 m pass a seat (on your right)., has no backrest.



After another 9 m turn left.



Then head down the earthen steps (about 65 m long)



Then pass the sign.



After another 120 m come to the viewpoint.



After another 30 m head down the surface|wood;metal;ground steps (about 460 m long)



Then pass a seat (on your right)., has no backrest.



After another 400 m turn right.



After another 85 m continue straight.



After another 20 m pass the sign.



After another 85 m head down the surface|wood steps (about 35 m long)



Then pass a seat (6 m on your left)., has a backrest.



After another 85 m turn left.



After another 10 m pass the sign.



Continue another 15 m to find the end. Then turn around here and retrace the main route for 1.2 km to get back to the start.
