

Mount Bogong Loop











Starting at the Mountain Creek Campsite, Alpine National Park, this loop walk takes you to the peak of Mount Bogong via the Staircase Spur and returns via the Eskdale Spur Trail. Embark on this adventurous hike over rugged terrain to the summit of the tallest mountain in Victoria. Visitors are rewarded with incredible views of the surrounding Victorian mountain range from the top. This walk is recommended for hikers with a good level of endurance and fitness. While the walk itself is not extreme, the weather can be, so come prepared. Weather conditions that include snow, high winds and fog can occur any time of year. It can be done as an overnight hike, with the Bivouac Hut area providing toilets and space to set up a tent. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Quality of track	Rough track, where fallen trees and other obstacles are likely (4/6)
Gradient	Very steep (4/6)
Signage	Directional signs along the way (3/6)
Infrastructure	Limited facilities (such as cliffs not fenced, significant creeks not bridged) (4/6)
Experience Required	Moderate level of bushwalking experience recommended (4/6)
Weather	Forecasted & unexpected severe weather likely to have an impact on your navigation and safety (5/6)



Getting to the start: From Hume Freeway, M31


- Turn on to Great Alpine Road Offramp then drive for 620 m
- Keep right onto Great Alpine Road Offramp and drive for another 120 m
- Turn right onto Great Alpine Road, B500 and drive for another 41.4 km
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Myrtle Street, B500 and drive for another 390 m
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Myrtle Street, B500 and drive for another 4.4 km
- Keep left and drive for another 65 m
- Continue onto Happy Valley Road, C534 and drive for another 33.8 km
- Turn right onto Kiewa Valley Highway, C531 and drive for another 20.2 km
- Turn left onto Ryders Lane and drive for another 10.6 km
- Turn right onto Mountain Creek Track and drive for another 40 m


Before you start any journey ensure you;


- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning

- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey


If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.





















After another 600 m veer right.















After another 2.5 km continue straight, to head along The Staircase.

After another 480 m (at the intersection of Michell Hut to Granite Spur & Eskdale Spur Track) veer left, to head along Eskdale Spur Track.

After another 30 m pass the "Michell Hut" (5 m on vour left).

After another 25 m pass the toilet (8 m on your left).

After another 1.2 km cross the ford

After another 1.2 km (at the intersection of Camp Creek Track & Eskdale Spur Track) turn left, to head along Camp Creek Track (a vehicle track).



After another 20 m turn left.



After another 520 m cross the bridge (about 10 m long)



After another 265 m turn left, to head along Mountain Creek Track.



After another 520 m cross the ford (about 5 m long)



After another 1.2 km cross the ford (about 20 m long)



After another 15 m cross the ford.



After another 990 m cross the ford.



Then cross the ford (about 7 m long)



After another 580 m continue straight, to head along Mountain Creek Track.

After another 4 m continue straight, to head along Mountain Creek Track.



After another 750 m (at the intersection of Mountain Creek Track & The Staircase) continue straight, to head along Mountain Creek Track.



After another 530 m turn left.



After another 85 m turn left, to head along Mountain Creek Track.



After another 265 m continue straight, to head along Mountain Creek Track.



After another 60 m veer right, to head along Mountain Creek Track.



After another 9 m cross the ford (about 6 m long)


