

Erskine Falls Extended Loop

🗧 7 h to 11 h



This walk starts near the Allenvale Road Carpark, at the end of Allenvale Road, Lorne, looping along the Otway Ranges following the Erskine River. Embark on a hike that takes you past Phantom Falls, the Cora Lynn Cascades, Lemonade Creek, Erskine Falls, Straw Falls, Splitter Falls and the Erskine River Rapids. Navigate through lush green foliage and mossy forest, with the gentle sound of the running stream throughout the hike. The walk is long and challenging, but at each waterfall, you are rewarded with spectacular views of water cascading over cliff faces. The trail is quite muddy and damp in some places. There are many river crossings across really slippery rocks, but with the help of hiking poles and some cautious stepping, you can make it through without wet shoes. This walk should not be attempted when the water levels are high. Dogs are allowed on a small portion of this trail, but most of the loop is in Great Otway National Park, which generally does not allow dogs. There is a campsite en route, and this hike can be completed with an overnight stop. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.


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Quality of track	Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles (3/6)
Gradient	Gentle hills with occasional steps (2/6)
Signage	Minimal directional signs (4/6)
Infrastructure	Generally useful facilities (such as fenced cliffs and seats) (2/6)
Experience Required	Some bushwalking experience recommended (3/6)
Weather	Foretasted & unexpected storms and severe weather may impact on navigation and safety (4/6)


Getting to the start: From Geelong Ring Road, M1

- Turn on to Anglesea Road Offramp, C134 then drive for 550 m
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Anglesea Road, C134 and drive for another 2.9 km
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Anglesea Road, C134 and drive for another 7.6 km
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Anglesea Road, C134 and drive for another 3.8 km
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Great Ocean Road, B100 and drive for another 50 m
- Make a U-turn onto Great Ocean Road, B100 and drive for another 55 m
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Great Ocean Road, B100 and drive for another 7.7 km
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Great Ocean Road, B100 and drive for another 3.7 km
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Great Ocean Road, B100 and drive for another 27.8 km
- Turn right onto Stirling Street and drive for another 120 m
- Turn left onto Dorman Street and drive for another 155 m
- Turn slight left onto Deans Marsh Road, C151 and drive for another 710 m
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Ocean Road, B100 and drive for another 350 m
- At roundabout, take exit 3 onto Otway Street and drive for another 870 m
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Allenvale Road and drive for another 1.5 km






Start of an optional side trip: Optional sidetrip to the Blanket Leaf Picnic Ground

> To start this optional side trip veer right here. Start.

After 460 m to find the car park.

- After another 15 m to find the toilet.
 - After another 9 m come to the end.


Turn around and retrace your steps back the 480 m to the main route.

Back at the main route turn right and follow on from the 7.7 km waypoint.





After another 800 m continue straight.



After another 2.4 km turn right.



After another 65 m pass a seat (8 m on your right).



After another 6 m head up the steps (about 70 m long)



Then pass a seat (on your right).



After another 60 m continue straight.




After another 255 m pass the "Straw Falls" (10 m on your left).



After another 1.6 km come to the "Splitter Falls Lookout" (15 m on your left).

After another 4.7 km cross the bridge (about 8 m lona)



Then come to the viewpoint.



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
