

Katherine Gorge & Baruwei Lookout










Starting from the southern car park at the end of Katherine Gorge Road, this circuit walk explores the escarpment alongside Katherine River via the Baruwei Loop Walk track, visiting Baruwei Lookout along the way. The lookout atop the escarpment provides you great views over the Katherine River and the western end of the same-titled gorge. If you're staying or living nearby, try to get up early and experience an amazing sunrise here. There are canoe and boat trips if you'd like to explore the river itself. Keep in mind that the track is quite exposed, wear a hat and bring plenty of water to better enjoy the hike. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.





Class 3 of 6 Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles	
Quality of track	Clear and well formed track or trail (2/6)
Gradient	Short steep hills (3/6)
Signage	Clearly signposted (2/6)
Infrastructure	Generally useful facilities (such as fenced cliffs and seats) (2/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (2/6)
Weather	Weather generally has little impact on safety (2/6)

Getting to the start: From Stuart Highway, 1


- Turn on to Giles Street then drive for 160 m
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Giles Street and drive for another 165 m
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Giles Street and drive for another 29.1 km
- Keep left and drive for another 30 m
- Turn right and drive for another 85 m
- Turn left and drive for another 25 m


Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.







Getting started: From the southern car park at the end of Katherine Gorge Road (near the Cicada Lodge), head along the walking track that starts towards Cicada Lodge, then veers left shortly after. Follow the said track as it heads southwest between the car park(to the left) and the caravan park(to the right). Stay on the track as it crosses the road near an intersection and heads parallel to it afterwards to continue along Katherine & Baruwei Lookout Track(counterclockwise).



Start.




Find the Katherine Gorge at the start.



After another 490 m continue straight.



After another 1.5 km pass the water tap (8 m on vour right).





After another 10 m come to the "Baruwei Lookout" (20 m on your right).



After another 30 m come to the viewpoint (on your right).

Start of an alternate route: An alternate route taking you closer to the river. There's a jetty where you can book canoe & boat trips as mentioned in the description.



To take the alternate route turn right here. **Start** heading along *Baruwei Loop* Walk.



After another 335 m turn left.



After another 60 m pass the toilet (20 m on your



After another 5 m come to the end.



At the end of this alternate route, rejoin the main route.



The alternate route finishes here. Continue straight to rejoin the main route at the 4.1 km waypoint.



After another 50 m continue straight, to head along Baruwei Loop Walk.



After another 410 m pass the car park (45 m on your left).



The alternate route finishes here. Continue straight to rejoin the main route at the 4.1 km waypoint.



Turn left.



After another 440 m find the "Nitmiluk Visitor" Centre" (15 m on your right).



After another 55 m veer right.



After another 55 m turn right.



After another 30 m come to the end.
