## Currawong Falls Circuit Walk

1 h 30 min to 2 h 45 min

Starting near the Distillery Creek Picnic Area on Bambra Road, Aireys Inlet, this walk takes you on a 11.5 km circuit via the Currawong Falls Track. This invigorating walk takes in great views of the ocean, surrounding countryside and Currawong Falls, before returning via a small fern gully and a melaluca swamp rich in birdlife. The track is clearly marked, and has several long fairly steep stretches. Be careful of mountain bikes speeding by, as parts of the track are shared with cyclists. The falls are often dry, and are best viewed during or after heavy rain. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.



Getting to the start: From Settlement Road, A10

- Turn on to Princes Freeway Onramp then drive for 1.5 km
- Keep left onto Anglesea Road Offramp, C134 and drive for another 550 m
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Anglesea Road, C134 and drive for another 2.9 km
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Anglesea Road, C134 and drive for another 7.6 km
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Anglesea Road, C134 and drive for another 3.8 km
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Great Ocean Road, B100 and drive for another 50 m
- Make a U-turn onto Great Ocean Road, B100 and drive for another 55 m
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Great Ocean Road, B100 and drive for another 7.7 km
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Great Ocean Road, B100 and drive for another 3.7 km
- At roundabout, take exit 2 onto Great Ocean Road, B100 and drive for another 9.4 km
- Turn right onto Boundary Road and drive for another 1 km
- Continue onto Boundary Road and drive for another 450 m
- Turn sharp right onto Bambra Road and drive for another 570 m
- Turn left onto Bambra Road and drive for another 400 m
- Turn left and drive for another 80 m
- Turn left and drive for another 0 m


## Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills \& knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures \& fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies \& call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.

## Share

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There is a car park (about 10 m back from the start).

After 50 m pass the toilet (on your left).


After another 40 m veer right, to head along Bambra Road.


## After another 85 m continue straight.

After another 90 m pass a seat ( 20 m on your right).
After another 45 m pass the picnic table ( 20 m on your right).

## Continue straight

After another 25 m pass the car park (on your right).


After another 3 m continue straight.


After another 5 m (at the intersection of Loves Track \& Currawong Falls Track) turn left, to head along Currawong Falls Track (a walking track)


After another 1.7 km come to the "Currawong Falls Lookout" ( 10 m on your right)

After another 1.8 km come to the "Melaleuca Swamp" (20 m on your left).


After another 1 km (at the intersection of Currawong Falls Track \& Currawong Falls Walking Track) continue straight to head along Currawong Falls Track.


After another 740 m (at the intersection of Currawong Falls Track \& Loves Track) veer right, to head along Currawong Falls Track.


After another 790 m (at the intersection of Currawong Falls Track \& Distillery Creek Nature Trail) continue straight, to head along Currawong Falls Track.
After another 10 m pass a seat (on your left).

After another 335 m pass a seat (on your left)


After another 140 m (at the intersection of Distillery Creek Nature Trail \& Currawong Falls Track) veer left, to head along Currawong Falls Track.


After another 35 m continue straight, to head along Currawong Falls Track.

After another 105 m pass the picnic table ( 10 m on your right).
