


Wasp Head Walk (Yuin Country)









Starting from the end of Wasp Head Road this return walk leads through historic Aboriginal sites to views over Wasp Island. Let us begin by acknowledging the Yuin people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.







Class 3 of 6 Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles	
Quality of track	Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles (3/6)
Gradient	Gentle hills with occasional steps (2/6)
Signage	Clearly signposted (2/6)
Infrastructure	Limited facilities, not all cliffs are fenced (3/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (2/6)
Weather	Storms may impact on navigation and safety (3/6)

Getting to the start: From Durras Drive

- Turn on to Allambee Street then drive for 165 m
- Turn slight left onto Banyandah Street and drive for another 1.2 km
- Turn left onto Wasp Head Road and drive for another 400 m


Before you start any journey ensure you;

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.
















Start of an optional side trip: Side trip to views over Wasp Island.














Turn around here and retrace the main route for 320 m to get back to the start.
