(Biripi & Worimi Country)



Starting at Mungo Brush Campsite this circuit walk takes you through the rainforest of Myall Lakes National Park. Enjoy the walk and then have a picnic at the campsite. Let us begin by acknowledging the Biripi & Worimi people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.



Class 3 of 6 Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles	
Quality of track	Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles (3/6)
Gradient	Short steep hills (3/6)
Signage	Directional signs along the way (3/6)
Infrastructure	Limited facilities, not all cliffs are fenced (3/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (2/6)
Weather	Storms may impact on navigation and safety (3/6)

Getting to the start: From

Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.







Start.




Find the sign at the start.




After another 215 m **continue straight.**




After another 60 m **veer left.**



After another 730 m **continue straight.**



After another 115 m come to the end.



Turn right.



After another 160 m **continue straight.**


Start of an optional side trip: Side trip to the top of Mungo Brush Hill.



To start this optional side trip turn left here. **Start.**



After another 120 m come to "Mungo Brush Hill".



The end.



Turn around and retrace your steps back the 120 m to the main route.



Back at the main route turn sharp right and follow on from the 490 m waypoint.
