

Starting from Victoria Park picnic are this circuit walk along a boardwalk is an accessible walk. Along the way you'll see great Morton Bay figs and other rainforest plants. Learn about them from informative displays, which explain how the local Widjabul Aboriginal people, of the Bundjalung nation, used the plants of the rainforest. Let us begin by acknowledging the Bundjalung people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Getting to the start: From Pacific Highway, A1

- Turn on to Carlisle Street, 28 then drive for 520 m
- Turn right onto Bath Street, 28 and drive for another 9.4 km
- Turn sharp left onto Dalwood Road and drive for another 1.9 km
- Turn left onto Victoria Park Road and drive for another 1.3 km
- Turn right onto Victoria Park Lane and drive for another 340 m



Before you start any journey ensure you;



- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning

 - Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
 - Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
 - Are healthy and fit enough for this journey
- If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.





Then pass the picnic table (20 m on your left).




Then pass the BBQ (20 m on your left).

After another 420 m come to the end.
