


Starting from the car park near Lake Leschenaultia Beach off Rosedale Road, Chidlow, this walk takes you on a circuit around the perimeter of Lake Leschenaultia. Lake Leschenaultia is a manmade freshwater lake nestled in the scenic bushland of Perth Hills. Explore the loop around the lake, and keep a lookout for the numerous species of native birds, kangaroos, possums and echidnas that live in the area. The walking trail around the lake is a flat path suitable for prams and children. This walk is also pleasurable in the warmer months as it is heavily shaded. Those with extra energy can also explore the off-road bush cycling trails. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Getting to the start: From Great Eastern Highway, 94


- Turn on to Old Northam Road then drive for 2.1 km
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Thomas Street and drive for another 335 m
- Turn sharp right onto Rosedale Road and drive for another 2.2 km
- Turn left and drive for another 30 m
- Turn left and drive for another 95 m


Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.









Getting started: From the carpark near Lake Leschenaultia Beach off Rosedale Road, Chidlow, head along the sealed path towards the picnic shelter near the lake's edge. Turn right at the picnic shelter and head along the walkway for about 300m, with a great view of the lake to your left. Follow the wide dirt trail ahead and continue the Lake Leschenaultia Loop(counterclockwise).




Start.





Lake Leschenaultia is a great spot for families as it offers many activities, both in and out of the lake. From having a picnic to riding a canoe, the area is suitable for people of all ages. There are BBQs, picnic tables, toilets and many more amenities present. Enjoy the refreshing ambience as you sunbathe on the pristine beaches of the lake.



After another 185 m pass the toilet (95 m on your right).

After another 460 m continue straight.



After another 180 m turn left.



After another 95 m continue straight.



After another 350 m turn left.



After another 245 m veer left.



After another 215 m continue straight.








After another 75 m continue straight.



After another 285 m turn left. Keep left.







Then come to the "Lake Lechenaultia" (50 m on your right).



After another 15 m find the "Reflections Café" (40 m on your right).

A great place to get breakfast, lunch or dinner, with a lovely playground and seating near the water's edge.



Continue straight.



After another 65 m come to the end.
