(Birpai Country)













Starting at Captain Cook Bicentennial Drive this challenging walk takes you to two lookouts and then through rainforest in Dooragan National Park all the way to Laurieton. Let us begin by acknowledging the Birpai people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.









Getting to the start: From Ocean Drive, 10, West Haven.


• Turn on to Captain Cook Bicentennial Drive then drive for 4.7 km


## Before you start any journey ensure you;

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.











Find the toilet at the start.

**Start of an optional side trip**: Side trip to a lookout with views.










Turn around and retrace your steps back the 8 m to the main route.


**Start of an optional side trip**: Side trip to Laurieton Lookout with great views.



Find the viewpoint at the start.

After another 20 m continue straight.

About 90 m past the end is "Don Johnstone Lookout".





Turn around and retrace your steps back the 65 m to the main route.


Back at the main route turn right and follow on from the 30 m waypoint.



After another 15 m come to the viewpoint (6 m on your left).









After another 225 m come to the end.
