

Junction Walk (Kamilaroi Country)








Let us begin by acknowledging the Kamilaroi people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

Getting to the start: From Yetman Road, 4


- Turn on to Wallangra Road, 4 then drive for 5 km
- Turn left onto Sandy Creek Road and drive for another 6.8 km
- Turn left onto Limestone Road and drive for another 7.6 km
- Keep left onto Limestone Road and drive for another 1.4 km
- Turn sharp right onto Lemon Tree Flat Road and drive for another 3.5 km


Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.
