(Wodi Wodi & Wandandian Country)











Starting from Murramarang Road car park this circuit walk takes you through Murramarang Aboriginal Area past middens and other Aboriginal sites. On the way you'll pass a lookout with great views to Brush Island. Let us begin by acknowledging the Wodi Wodi & Wandandian people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.






Class 3 of 6 Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles	
Quality of track	Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles (3/6)
Gradient	Gentle hills with occasional steps (2/6)
Signage	Clearly signposted (2/6)
Infrastructure	Limited facilities, not all cliffs are fenced (3/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (2/6)
Weather	Storms may impact on navigation and safety (3/6)


## Before you start any journey ensure you;


- $\bullet$  Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- $\bullet$  Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.











After 15 m to find the car park.



After another 200 m pass the sign (on your right).



After another 8 m continue straight.



After another 470 m turn right.

After another 380 m come to the viewpoint (on your right).

After another 400 m cross the bridge (about 6 m long)







After another 580 m come to a car park.
