

## Weribee Gorge Circuit via the Short Circuit Track










Starting from the Meikles Point Picnic Area on Myers Road, Ingliston, this walk takes you on a small loop within the Weribee Gorge State Park via the Short Circuit Track. Enjoy a short hike that allows you to experience the wild, rugged natural beauty of Weribee Gorge State Park, offering impressive views of both the river and the cliff faces of the gorge. Koalas, wallabies and echidnas can be spotted along the way. This is a short but challenging hike on a well defined dirt trail, with some rocky sections and some steep ascents and descents. There is lot of gravel in sections and it becomes rather slippery under the feet. The walk is suitable for most ages and fitness levels, but some bushwalking experience and physical endurance is required. This walk is highly trafficked, and it's a good idea to go early if you wish to avoid the crowds. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.





Class 4 of 6 Rough track, where fallen trees and other obstacles are likely	
Quality of track	Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles (3/6)
Gradient	Very steep (4/6)
Signage	Clearly signposted (1/6)
Infrastructure	Limited facilities, not all cliffs are fenced (3/6)
Experience Required	Some bushwalking experience recommended (3/6)
Weather	Storms may impact on navigation and safety (3/6)



Getting to the start: From Western Highway, 8


- Turn on to Western Highway, 8 then drive for 34.2 km
- Keep left onto Mortons Road Offramp and drive for another 510 m
- Turn right onto Mortons Road and drive for another 205 m
- Turn left onto Pentland Hills Road and drive for another 2.8 km
- Turn left onto Myers Road and drive for another 2.1 km
- Keep left and drive for another 550 m
- $\bullet\,$  Turn sharp left and drive for another 1.1 km


## Before you start any journey ensure you;


- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- · Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.












Find the car park at the start.



After another 80 m continue straight.



After another 160 m continue straight.

After another 65 m pass the toilet (on your right).



After another 50 m **veer left**, to head along Gorge Circuit Walk.



After another 25 m (at the intersection of Centenary Track & Gorge Circuit Walk) continue straight, to head along Gorge Circuit Walk.

**Start of an optional side trip**: Optional side trip to the Eastern Viewpoint

To start this optional side trip continue straight here. at the intersection of Gorge Circuit Walk & Short Circuit Track **Start** heading along *Gorge Circuit Walk* (a walking track).

After another 35 m turn right.

Continue another 65 m to find Eastern Viewpoint at the end.

"Eastern Viewpoint".

Turn around and retrace your steps back the 100 m to the main route.

Back at the main route ERROR >360 and follow on from the 2.4 km waypoint.

After another 440 m (at the intersection of Gorge Circuit Walk & Short Circuit Track) **turn left**, to head along Short Circuit Track.



After another 1.7 km (at the intersection of Short Circuit Track & Gorge Circuit Walk) **turn sharp left**, to head along Gorge Circuit Walk.
