

## Murray Scrub Walking Track (Bundjalung Country)










Walk through these section of Toonumbar National Park on a journey amoung the enormous trees in this lush rainforest. Feel small amongst the giant Bangalow palms, strangler figs and an oldgrowth stand of red cedar trees. Let us begin by acknowledging the Bundjalung people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.









- Turn on to Coxs Road then drive for 11.4 km
- Turn slight left onto Toonumbar Forest Drive and drive for another 10.3 km
- Turn sharp right onto Murray Scrub Road and drive for another 3.8 km
- Turn right onto Murray Scrub Carpark Road and drive for another 490 m





## Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.







**Getting started:** Drive to the end of Murray Scrub car park road just off Murray Scrub Rd, Toonumbar. Continue straight to the end of the car park to start the signposted walk.

After another 1.5 km **veer right**.



After another 1.9 km continue straight.



After another 1.5 km come to the end.
