


## Sea Acres Rainforest Boardwalk

(Birpai Country)











Starting at Sea Acres Rainforest Centre this leisurely circuit walk is best done as a guided tour. There's an entry fee. The walk takes you along the elevated boardwalk to give you a unique view over the forest. Let us begin by acknowledging the Birpai people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.







Class 1 of 6 Smooth and hardened path	
Quality of track	Smooth and hardened path (1/6)
Gradient	Flat, no steps (1/6)
Signage	Clearly signposted (1/6)
Infrastructure	Generally useful facilities (such as fenced cliffs and seats) (1/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (1/6)
Weather	Weather generally has little impact on safety (1/6)

**Getting to the start**: From Ocean Drive, 10, Port Macquarie.


- Turn on to Pacific Drive, 10 then drive for 1.1 km
- At roundabout, take exit 1 onto Pacific Drive, 10 and drive for another 270 m
- Turn right onto Pacific Drive, 10 and drive for another 850 m
- Turn right and drive for another 75 m


## Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.







**Getting started:** From the car park off Pacific Drive, Port Macquarie, head towards the cafe/visitor centre along the paved path. Go through the said building, then keep right at the 3-way intersection to continue along Sea Acres Rainforest Boardwalk (counterclockwise).





Then cross the bridge



Find the car park at the start.



Find the toilet at the start.



Find the Rainforest Café at the start. W:www.rainforestcafe.com.au



Veer right.



Then cross the bridge



After another 195 m pass the "Calwalla Reserve" (195 m on your right).



Then cross the bridge



After another 470 m cross the bridge



After another 660 m turn right.
