


## Bald Rock Summit Circuit (Jukembal Country)










Starting from Bald Rock picnic area this circuit walk in Bald Rock National Park takes you up to the Australia's largest granite rock to a scenic view over the national park. The walk connects Bungoona walk and Bald Rock Summit walk into a loop walk. Let us begin by acknowledging the Jukembal people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.






Class 3 of 6 Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles	
Quality of track	Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles (3/6)
Gradient	Short steep hills (3/6)
Signage	Clearly signposted (2/6)
Infrastructure	Limited facilities, not all cliffs are fenced (3/6)
Experience Required	Some bushwalking experience recommended (3/6)
Weather	Storms may impact on navigation and safety (3/6)

Getting to the start: From Mount Lindesay Road, 7

• Turn on to Bald Rock Road then drive for 5.4 km





## Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey


If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.








**Getting started:** From Bald Rock picnic area car park, head towards the sheltered trailhead signpost with a "Please pay fees here" sign on it along the paved/gravel path. Pass between the said signpost and a green "Bald Rock Climb - Carrolls Creek Walk - Border Walk" sign and head along the narrow walking track. About 90 metres in, veer left at the fork and join the Bungoona Walk to continue along Bald Rock Summit Circuit (clockwise).



There is a BBQ (about 40 m back from the start).



Find the sign at the start.

After another 25 m (from the Bald Rock Summit Walk) **continue straight**, to head along Bald Rock Summit Walk.

After another 25 m cross the bridge (about 9 m long)

After another 20 m (at the intersection of Bald Rock Summit Walk & Bungoona Walk) **turn left**, to head along Bungoona Walk.

After another 330 m cross the bridge (about 6 m long)

After another 180 m cross the bridge (about 2 m long)


**Start of an optional side trip**: This is the side trip that takes you atop the humongous Bald Rock.

To start this optional side trip turn left here. at the intersection of Bald Rock Summit Walk & Bungoona Walk **Start** heading along *Bald Rock Summit Walk* (a walking track).

After another 460 m (from the Bald Rock Summit Walk) **veer right**, to head along Bald Rock Summit Walk.

After another 105 m pass the "Bald Rock" (5 m on your left).

Turn around and retrace your steps back the 610 m to the main route.

Back at the main route turn right and follow on from the 2 km waypoint.

After another 1.4 km (at the intersection of Bald Rock Summit Walk & Bungoona Walk) **turn right**, to head along Bald Rock Summit Walk.

After another 320 m head up the stone steps (about 10 m long)


After another 55 m pass a seat (on your right)., has a backrest.


Then cross the bridge (about 15 m long)

After another 30 m cross the bridge (about 15 m long)



After another 190 m (at the intersection of Bungoona Walk & Bald Rock Summit Walk) continue straight, to head along Bald Rock Summit Walk.







After another 40 m come to the end.
