


## Circuit Flat Walking Track (Darug & Darkinjung Country)









Starting from Mogo Creek Road near Mogo campground this walk takes you through Yengo National Park along a non signaged track. On the way you will see the fourth-oldest bridge in Australia called Circuit Flat Bridge. Let us begin by acknowledging the Darug & Darkinjung people, Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.

	Weather	Forecasted & unexpected severe weather likely to have an impact on your navigation and safety (5/6)

- Turn on to Settlers Road then drive for 6.3 km
- · Turn left and drive for another 6 m


## Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- · Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.







**Shape must have at least 2 pairs of points** 







After another 130 m turn left.



After another 65 m pass the toilet (65 m on your right).



After another 25 m come to the "Mogo Camping Area - Yengo NP" (15 m on your right).

After another 3 km turn left.



After another 115 m **turn left**, to head along Old North Road.



After another 2 km (at the intersection of Great North Road & Old North Road) **turn left**, to head along Mogo Creek Road (a highway|tertiary).



After another 500 m turn left.
