

Ancient Empire Walk Trail










Starting from the Treetop Walk Car Park, Tingledale, this circuit walk takes you to The Ancient Empire Trail. The area is home to unique flora and giant tingle trees such as The 450-year-old Grandma Tingle. You can also walk through the hollows of other trees and even take photos inside them. Families of Fairywrens will accompany you through the walk, and the informative signs along the trail are a bonus. There are useful facilities and a lot of shade, and it is open all year round except for Christmas and during extreme weather conditions like lightning and storms. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.









Getting to the start: From South Coast Highway, 1, Tingledale.


- Turn on to Anderson Road then drive for 680 m
- Turn sharp right onto Valley of the Giants Road and drive for another 3.3 km
- Continue onto Big Tree Road and drive for another 950 m


Before you start any journey ensure you;

- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning
- · Have adequate equipment, supplies, skills & knowledge to undertake this journey safely
- Consider weather forecasts, park/track closures & fire dangers
- · Can respond to emergencies & call for help at any point
- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey

If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.











- Treetop Walk Carpark (about 145 m back from the start).
- Treetop Walk Carpark (about 55 m back from the start).
- Find the Welcome to the valley of the giants: Tree Top Walk at the start.
- After another 85 m pass a seat (120 m on your right).



After another 20 m pass the toilet (5 m on your left).



After another 10 m turn left.



- Then cross the bridge (about 15 m long)
- After another 140 m pass the "Treetop Walk Carpark" (155 m on your left).




Then head up the steps (about 4 m long)



After another 20 m head up the steps (about 8 m long)



Continue straight.





Then head up the steps (about 10 m long)



After another 45 m pass a seat (10 m on your left).



After another 30 m head down the steps (about 10 m long)



After another 20 m veer right.

- After another 160 m pass the "Treetop Walk Carpark" (160 m on your left).
- Then pass a seat (on your left).





After another 100 m **turn right**.



After another 30 m turn right.



After another 85 m come to the end.
