


Cockatoo Loop










Starting from McNess House Visitor Centre and Gift Shop in Yanchep National Park, Yanchep, this walk gives you a tour of the area. You can observe the wildlife, including kangaroos, wallabies and even Carnaby Black Cockatoos if lucky. The trail has directional signage, and the vegetation mainly consists of wildlife flowers. You might want to visit this area at a cooler time of the year as there is not a lot of shade. If you are visiting during summer, you might want to take ample water with you. Let us begin by acknowledging the Traditional Custodians of the land on which we travel today, and pay our respects to their Elders past and present.






Class 3 of 6 Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles	
Quality of track	Formed track, with some branches and other obstacles (3/6)
Gradient	Gentle hills with occasional steps (2/6)
Signage	Clearly signposted (2/6)
Infrastructure	Generally useful facilities (such as fenced cliffs and seats) (2/6)
Experience Required	No experience required (2/6)
Weather	Weather generally has little impact on safety (2/6)



- Turn on to Yanchep National Park then drive for 900 m
- At roundabout, take exit 2 and drive for another 210 m
- Turn left and drive for another 80 m





Before you start any journey ensure you;


- Tell someone you trust where you are going and what to do if you are late returning

- Are healthy and fit enough for this journey


If not, change plans and stay safe. It is okay to delay and ask people for help.


























Getting started: From the car park next to McNess House Visitor Centre and Gift Shop, move towards the dark green "Yanchep, No Entry Service Vehicles Only" sign. Follow the asphalt road as you get closer to the visitor centre (on your left). Pass beside the black metal door and walk towards 4 informational signs that you can see from the back. Afterwards, turn right and continue along the Cockatoo Loop.



- Find the McNess House Visitors Centre at the start.
- Find the toilet at the start.



- After another 125 m pass the toilet (125 m on your left).
- Then pass the cafe (25 m on your left).
- After another 140 m pass the car park (175 m on your left).







After another 150 m come to the "Henry White Oval" (90 m on your left).



- After another 10 m come to the "Yanchep National Park" (35 m on your left).
- After another 35 m come to the "Henry White Oval" (45 m on your left).



After another 10 m pass the "Yonderup Cave" (80 m on your right).




After another 85 m to find the car park.



- After another 40 m turn right.
- After another 40 m pass the "Crystal Cave" (6 m on your left).

























About 125 m past the end is a toilet.



After another 45 m turn right.



After another 60 m continue straight.



After another 195 m come to the "Henry White Oval".



Turn sharp left.



After another 45 m turn right.



After another 105 m continue straight.




After another 30 m come to the "Henry White Oval" (30 m on your right).



After another 25 m come to the end.



After another 320 m veer left.




After another 25 m to find the car park.



After another 110 m continue straight.

After another 250 m pass the car park (55 m on your right).



After another 40 m turn left.



Continue straight.



After another 35 m turn left.
